- Formation of the innovative mechanisms of international cooperation.
- The role of universities in ensuring the post-war development of Ukraine.
- Environmental social and cultural aspects of the post-war revival of Ukraine's territories.
- Migration and labor supply for the post-war recovery and development of Ukraine's economy.
- Organizational, economic and security aspects of Ukraine's development.
- Restoration of tourism in Ukraine in the post-war period.
- Marketing and branding of the Ukrainian's territories in the post-war period.
- Effective governance for the post-war reconstruction of Ukraine.
- Development and practical implementation of the legal doctrine under conditions of the post-war reconstruction of Ukraine.
- The information and communication technologies for the post-war reconstruction of Ukraine.

Guidelines for submitting the abstracts, template:

File format of text documents: Microsoft Word DOCX/DOC.

Graphic images in the text (drawings, photographs, graphs, diagrams, charts) should be submitted additionally in a separate file in PDF or PNG format.

For the text, use Times New Roman 12pt font with single line spacing. Paragraph indentation should be 1.25 mm.

Margins and page size:

A4 paper size: (210×297)

Left margin: 20 mm

Right margin: 20 mm

Top margin: 20 mm

Bottom margin: 20 mm

Structure of the text of abstracts:

Information about the author: in the upper right corner - in bold name and surname, academic title, position, email address, ORCID.

Title of the abstract: in capital letters, bold, centered, after the information about the author.

The main text is single-spaced.

The maximum length for abstract up to 2 pages (including tables, figures and references).

A source reference must be provided for each table and figure. Tables should have a title located above the table.

Equations should be in MS Equation or MathType format, centered and labeled.

Equations, figures, tables, in the text should be referred as: Eq. (1), Eqs. (1) and (2); Fig. 1; Table 1.

In the text citations should follow the author- date method whereby the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, for example, (Jones, 1998).

The complete reference list should appear alphabetically by name at the end of the paper without numbering.
