Guidelines for Abstract Submissions

The abstract must be submitted in the format of an MS Word (.doc or .docx) document. Type – Times New Roman; size 12; all margins – 2 cm; line spacing – 1,5; indentation – 1,25; justified text; no double spaces; no page numbers. The recommended word limit is 250-500.

Surname and first name of the author, information about the education degree, educational and professional program / academic degree, position and institution of higher education must be indicated in italics, right alignment. The title of the abstract – in capital letters, centred. A translation of the title and a summary in English (2-4 sentences) with keywords are required if the language of publication is other than English. References in the text should be given in square brackets and include the number of listed source and the page number, separated by a comma.

Title of the abstract and summary (2-4 sentences) in English (necessarily, if the abstract is in a language other than English).
